# A Community Assessment for Global Grant Project on Basic Education and Literacy in 10 Schools

In the month of August 2023, the Rotary Club of Yala conducted a community school assessment and diagnostic level test for TaRL (Teaching at the Right Level), a pivotal step for the upcoming Global Grant Project in 10 different schools. Distinguished Rotarians including Rtn Pramod Sagar Pradhan, Rtn Gautam Shrestha, Rtn Dharmendra Shakya, Rtn Surendra Gopal Shrestha, Rtn Shobha Shrestha, Rtn Kanti Shrestha, Rtn Manjari Tamrakar, Rtn Om Krishna Shrestha, Rtn

Dr Dinesh Lal Shrestha, Rtn Om Shanker Shrestha, Rtn Jiban Pradhan, and Rtn Narahari Joshi collaborated alongside Ann Usha Pradhan, Nirmala Shrestha, and enthusiastic Rotaract members to drive this assessment initiative.

Over the past two decades, Nepal has made substantial strides in education, with a remarkable 90% net enrolment rate in primary schools. However, challenges persist, encompassing issues such as unequal access, geographical isolation, gender disparities, and socioeconomic divisions. Barriers to attendance encompass poverty, social exclusion, disability, migration, child labor, and gender biases. This project aims to: (1) Foster foundational education in schools to expedite learning recovery. (2) Galvanize school management networks as a sustainable platform, enhancing children's educational access.



















#### **Blood Donation, Free PAP Smear Test and Breast Examination**


The Rotary Club of Yala, in association with the Nepal Cancer Hospital and Research Centre, Kanibahal Ward #6, and the Nepal Cancer Relief Society Lalitpur, organized a joint event which included Blood Donation, Free PAP Smear Test, and Breast Examination on Saturday, August 12th, 2023, at Ward No. 6, Kanibahal. This event was successfully accomplished and was dedicated to ensuring the betterment of public health. The camp witnessed the participation of a large group of people spanning ages 18 to 76.

A total of 76 women underwent Pap smear tests and breast examinations, while 14 blood donors generously donated blood. The event attracted the participation of more than 200 people.
