### Handover of Table Tennis Board for Visually Impaired

On July 6th, 2025, The Rotary Club of Yala handed over a Table Tennis board specially designed for visually impaired students to the Disable Service Association, Bungamati, Lalitpur, aiming to promote sports and recreational opportunities for visually impaired students.

The board, worth Rs.55,000, was generously supported by Rtn. Padam Krishna Shrestha and Rtn Urmila Shrestha of the Club. Chief Coach Kumar Poudel conducted a demonstration on how Table Tennis is played by visually impaired players.

In addition to the equipment, a one-month Table Tennis training program by a professional trainer of Nepal Table Tennis Association will also be arranged. The training cost of Rs.15,000 has also been kindly borne by Rtn. Padam Krishna Shrestha.

The handover program was graced by the presence of national blind Table Tennis player Shiva Agrawal and chief coach Kumar Poudel, who shared their experiences and encouraged the participants. Rotarians and Anns of the



Rotary Club of Yala were also present at the event, showing their collective support for this meaningful initiative. This initiative stands as a testament to Rotary Club of Yala's ongoing commitment to inclusion, accessibility, and empowerment through sports.



### Scholarship Distribution in Clark Himalaya Memorial School



The Rotary Club of Yala in collaboration with the Anns Group, organized a meaningful and heartwarming initiative at Clark Himalayan Memorial School in Bungamati, Lalitpur on 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2025. A total of 30 brilliant students of the school having poor financial states received scholarships of NPR 10,500 each, totaling NPR 315,000 to support their education and ease the financial burden on their families.

In addition to scholarships, the Club also provided NPR 104,000 to fund daily tiffin for children in Nursery and KG for the year. The tiffin support is a small gesture with a big impact making sure these little ones are not studying on an empty stomach and their attendance remains constant.

### Joint Rotary Club Tree Plantation

In alignment with RI District 3292's ambitious initiative to plant 50,000 trees in a single day as part of Rotary Tree Plantation Day 2025, under the theme "Let's Unite to Save the Environment", a successful joint tree plantation program was organized by five clubs named Rotary Club of Yala, Rotary Club of Patan, Rotary Club of Balaju, Rotary Club of Kathmandu and Rotary Club of Bagmati Kathmandu on July 26 at Kirat Ban, Sano Hattiban, Lalitpur.

More than 80 enthusiastic participants from five Rotary Clubs came together to contribute to this green mission, planting over 650 native tree saplings along with 500 vertiver and 500 Kush grass nursery using the Japanese Miyawaki afforestation technique. This initiative was successfully carried out with the support of the
