## Free Eye Screening & Cataract Surgery Camp

Under the theme "Unite for Good", 15 Rotary Clubs of RI District 3292 have jointly organized a "Free Eye Screening & Cataract Surgery Camp" at Pancha Kanya Secondary School, Kulekhani, Indrasarowar Rural Municipality for five days, 3 – 7th December, 2025. with the support of Rotary Clubs of Tasmania & Mr David Yasley, Australia, local partner -Indrasarowar Rural Municipality, and the technical support of Hetauda Community Eye Hospital, Makawanpur.

Total 329 people from different VDCs of the Rural Municipality were examined and 59 successful cataract surgery have done.

During the camp, Lodging and fooding were provided to the patients.
